

The Starflake Quilt Workshop Blair Stocker



Required Kit- the Starflake Quilt Pattern and Blair's Ruby Ruler®- \$28- Purchase at this link, and I will bring to workshop for you. There is an image of the back of the pattern with a full list of yardage needed at the required kit supply link.

Fabric needed for class- The more fabrics the better, so plan on bringing many different printed quilting weight fabrics (no solids). If you would like to focus on one particular color for

this quilt, as I did with green, plan accordingly. This is a great opportunity to use fat quarters, charm packs, scraps, etc. You will want a minimum of 40-50 different fabrics to work with during the workshop, and don't worry that the fabrics may not seem to "go together". You can duplicate a fabric a few times in the quilt, but you'll want variety. Refer to the back pattern cover for the total amount of yardage needed to complete your chosen quilt size. For the class sample, I pulled fabrics from my green scrap bin, then changed to pinks at the top left. You can pull scraps from one color group, or make it super scrappy and use all kinds of prints/colors.

Other Supplies Needed-

Rotary Cutter with a fresh blade/Cutting Mat
Preferred acrylic cutting rulers for fat quarters, ydg, or scraps into 3 ½" and 4 ½" squares
Sewing machine with a fresh needle and neutral cotton thread
A design wall
Iron/ironing surface
Pins
Fabric scissors
Seam Ripper
